

**Scholarship Information
For
District Deputies and Grand Knights**

1. Our program is open to any Catholic in good standing, not just members of the Knights of Columbus.
2. The program is setup to help defray the post secondary costs of students so they may continue their education. The student has to be applying to a state approved institution. The scholarship application and posters are being made available which will clearly indicate that the program is for post secondary study at a University, College, or Community College beyond the secondary level.
3. It should be pointed out that any forms which are mailed out from our committee go to the Grand Knight of the council and it is his responsibility to pass on any information to his local scholarship representative. On that matter, the DD's should direct any questions on the local level to the Grand Knight. Many times misunderstandings can be cleared up with one phone call to the local level and then, if necessary to a member of our committee.
4. We would appreciate councils following the time lines which are set down in the letter which accompanies the scholarship information. These time lines are important for all to do a good job and will give ample time for a just and fair consideration to all applications. Many times in the past, the state committee has received applications up to a few days before convention. It is imperative that we have **all applications** in our hands by the middle of April. The actual date is specified in the cover letter.
5. Our committee recommends that a photo be taken at the local level of the presentation of the certificate to the successful applicant and if possible, would you please forward a copy of this to the secretary of the state scholarship committee. It is also suggested that it would be good for local public relations if such photo could be published in your local newspaper.
